February 6th and 7th, 2010 Once again we have set aside a special area in the Park for children's activities. There will be no charge to rent spaces in this area. However, space assignments will be made in accordance with general interest, public appeal, or entertainment value. You may charge a small fee, engage in fundraising activities to benefit your organization, or pass out promotional information. You must comply with all other Park rules, including: Set-Up Friday 9AM -6PM Saturday & Sunday 6AM-8:30AM  
Stay Open Saturday & Sunday 9AM-4PM during Fair Hours  
Clean-Up After 4PM Sunday. All clean-up is your organization's responsibility.  
All vehicles must be removed from the Park by 8:30AM unless they are part of the exhibit itself. This is a public safety issue. Absolutely no vehicles may be driven in the Park from 9AM to 4PM. Please see the information tent for a parking permit that should be displayed on your rearview mirror and will allow your entrance during set-up and tear-down hours.

## COMMUNICATIONS PLAN:

Citizens radios will be furnished to fair officials. The radios will be pre-programed and locked on Channel 9. Officers assigned to the event at night and on day shift will be monitoring these radios. The on duty Lake Placid Officer will also have one of the radios on but may not be able to hear transmissions unless they are close to the fair. The range on these radios is about 1/2 mile.

Police will also be monitoring regular police frequencies. A call to 911 will produce a police officer should any emergency occur.

Chief Williams will be available by cell phone or citizen radio if in range.

## OFFICER ASSIGNMENT:

Officer Jerry Perez and Captain Richard Morey will be on duty for fair activities Saturday from 8:00AM to 4:00PM  
Officer Perez will be on duty Saturday at 7AM

Cpl. Mark Schneider will be working day shift 6AM to 6PM both Saturday and Sunday

Officer Eddie Conklin will be working night watch duty at the fair both Friday night and Saturday night. 7PM to 6AM

Officers Kerry Lanier and JB Benton will be on duty for fair activities Sunday from 7:00AM to 4:00PM

## OFFICER DUTIES:

Officers are to be on patrol, primarily foot, to maintain order both traffic and pedestrian as needed. No predesignated traffic control by hand direction will be assigned. Officers should use discretion and apply if needed. Officers will have some traffic device controls available if needed such as cones.

Night shift officer will provide security for vendors booths.
